# New law in affect...

A crematory operator permit must be obtained to comply with new law. Applicants must successfully complete a Crematory Operator CertificationProgram approved by the state of Ohio Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors. Beginning January 1, 2019,  $applicants\ must\ also$ show proof of completion of a two hour Ohio crematory law course. This seven hour course is fully compliant.
