When traveling to Barbados, it's essential to ensure that your passport is valid for at least six months beyond your intended arrival date, as this is a requirement for entry. The official currency of Barbados is the Barbadian Dollar (BBD), although US Dollars (USD) are widely accepted throughout the island, especially in tourist areas, making it convenient for visitors. The island enjoys a warm tropical climate year-round, with average temperatures in January ranging from 75°F to 84°F, offering ideal weather for beach activities, sightseeing, and outdoor adventures.
