Clothing Recommendations

For your Holland America cruise through New England and Canada in June, dress much like you would for a stylish land-based resort. The weather can be unpredictable, with daytime temperatures usually in the mid to upper 70s°F and evenings cooling into the 50s°F, so layering is key. Be sure to pack a sweater, jacket, or light coat for cooler evenings, along with a hat or visor and a compact umbrella for sudden weather changes. Comfortable, low-heeled, rubber-soled shoes are ideal for walking on deck, and sturdy walking shoes are a must for shore excursions.

Onboard, the dress code varies by venue and occasion. Casual attire like jeans, polos, sundresses, and blouses is perfect for daytime and pool areas, while shorts are welcome at breakfast and lunch. Smart casual is the go-to for dinners and evening activities, with collared shirts, dresses, skirts, blouses, and blazers encouraged. There are usually up to two formal nights during the cruise where black-tie attire, such as suits, tuxedos, cocktail dresses, or evening gowns, is appropriate. If you prefer to skip formal wear, smart casual attire is always acceptable in dining rooms and theaters.

Deposit and Final Payment

A deposit is due upon booking and to secure your reservation. Final payment is due on or before the final payment date listed in the brochure.

Airline Requests & Seats

Traveler/Security Information (TSA/KTN numbers, Frequent Flyer numbers, etc) and Special Requests (medical, dietary, etc) will be forwarded to the airline at the time of ticketing. It is the traveler's responsibility to reconfirm these requests directly with the airline upon airport check-in. All seats are assigned at the airline's discretion. Travelers with the same last name are typically seated together; however, World of Travel has no control over final seat assignments. In-Class seat changes/upgrades (i.e., Preferred Seats) are to be confirmed by the traveler(s) directly with the airline, after ticketing is complete (30–60 days prior to departure). Class upgrades must be requested prior to Final Payment. NOTE: If booking flights using Frequent Flyer Miles, the traveler(s) must purchase their tickets directly from the airline. In this instance, an air credit will be applied to the traveler(s) final payment invoice. Air credits vary per trip.

Cancellation Schedule

All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations received before the final payment date are subject to an administration fee of \$100 per person. Cancellations received after the final payment date are non-refundable.

Travel/Health Policy

It is required that persons needing assistance be accompanied by a companion who is capable and totally responsible for providing that assistance.
