Day-by-Day Itinerary

Saturday, September 12

Depart your home city this morning. Meet your connecting flight and fly overnight to Shannon, Ireland.

Sunday, September 13

Arrive early this morning in Shannon. Upon arrival, transfer via motor coach to the quaint Irish hamlet of Adare. Our accommodations for the next five nights will be The Dunraven - A luxury, country house established in County Limerick in 1792. Enjoy a lovely walking tour of this historic village with our local guide before a delicious Welcome Dinner at a local establishment.

Monday, September 14

Travel to the stunning Cliffs of Moher, towering above the churning waters of the North Atlantic. Then, drive through The Burren & be amazed by the incredible landscape of glacial-era limestone, dotted with cliffs, caves, unique flora & wildlife. Later, immerse yourself in farm life as you watch highly skilled sheepdogs herd their flock. This evening, enjoy a group dinner at The Dunraven.

Tuesday, September 15

Journey to the rugged, mountainous landscapes of the Dingle Peninsula. In the charming village of Dingle, stop for lunch at a local pub then enjoy free time in the heart of town. Later, visit the South Pole Inn and enjoy a drink as you hear the story of the pub's former owner, Ireland's Antarctic explorer, Thomas Crean. Return to Adare and have the evening at your leisure.

Wednesday, September 16

Take one of Ireland's most scenic rail journeys from Cork to the seaport town of Cobh. Its picturesque harbor was the last glimpse of Ireland of millions of emigrants over the centuries, including those who boarded here for Titanic's maiden voyage. After a walking tour with a local guide, enjoy free time to explore on your own. Later, continue to Blarney Castle, where you can kiss the "Stone of Eloquence" and explore the elegant gardens. Dinner this evening will be hosted by The Dunraven.

Thursday, September 17

Today, enjoy the highlights of the Ring of Kerry, taking in the rugged coastline, mountainous landscapes, and scenic Ladies View, so named because Queen Victoria's ladies-in-waiting were so charmed by the vista during the Queen's visit in 1861. In Killarney, travel via jaunting car to view the lakes at picturesque Ross Castle, followed by time at leisure to explore the town. A delicious Farewell Dinner is included this evening at The Dunraven.

Day-by-Day Continued

Friday, September 18

Depart Adare this morning & travel to Dublin. Upon arrival, enjoy a group lunch at Taylors Three Rock, including a band performance of traditional Irish music. Continue to our hotel in the heart of Dublin and check-in for a two night stay. The remaining day is yours to explore this iconic European capital city.

Saturday, September 19

Explore Dublin independently on a Hop-on/Hop-off bus tour. The provided voucher will admit you to your choice of one of the city's top attractions: Guinness Storehouse, GPO Museum, EPIC Museum, Teeling Whiskey Distillery, or Jameson Distillery Bow Street Experience.

Sunday, September 20

Depart Dublin this morning on our return flights to the US. Arrive in your home city later this evening.
